PERMANENT MAKEUP WAIVER

Permanent Makeup Information & Eligibility

Permanent make-up procedure typically requires multiple treatment sessions. For best results, clients will need to return for a touch up appointment, (fees are listed on Glow North's website). With rare cases, a client may not need the perfecting session. Other cases, they may need an additional one. This perfecting session will take place between 6-8 weeks after the initial procedure. Please be aware that colour intensity will be significantly darker and sharper immediately after the initial procedure and will reduce by 20-50%.

Although numbing cream is used during the procedure, sensitivity/discomfort may still be felt by some clients. Each individual's pain tolerance is different. Some clients report the area to be completely numb, while others may experience some discomfort. Some clients may experience bleeding, however this can usually be avoided by following the preparation instructions given to you. Skin may be red and/or swollen after the procedure. This will subside over the following few days.

After your initial and touch up sessions, you will be eligible for Maintenance treatment pricing. Maintenance pricing is ONLY applicable if you have completed your initial treatment and consultation/session with GLOW NORTH. As everyone heals and processes pigment differently, there is no time limit in which you must have a maintenance treatment done. In order to be considered a maintenance treatment you must have a least 30% of your prior treatment still visible. Any major changes to shape or size or permanent make up which has faded more than 30% will require a new initial treatment.

On rare occasions, the pigment may migrate under the skin. Permanent makeup cannot be applied if you are pregnant, or to anyone under the age of 18 (without consent of a legal guardian). Infections are rare but can occur. This risk of infection greatly decreases if aftercare instructions are followed correctly. If you have an MRI scan within 3 months after permanent makeup procedure, you should notify/discuss with your doctor. Possible scarring may occur, but is rare.

Contraindications for semi-permanent make-up:

- Liver disease – high risk of infection
- Pregnancy
- Compromised skin near brow area
- HIV or Hepatitis or any other infectious or viral diseases
- Undergoing Chemotherapy
- Hormone therapies – can affect pigmentation and/or cause sensitivity

The following medical conditions require your due diligence to discuss procedure eligibility with your doctor:

- Diabetes Type 1 and 2 (including pre-diabetic conditions)
- High blood pressure
- Nursing
- Auto-immune disease
- Thyroid / Graves' disease
- Cancer / Past Chemotherapy/Radiation / Cancer Remission
- Any other medical condition that causes slow healing or high risk of infection

Informed Consent

Please read the following information carefully:

- If an unforeseen condition arises in the course of the procedure, I authorize my technician to use her professional judgment to decide what she feels is necessary under the given circumstances. I accept the responsibility for determining the color, shape and position of the permanent make-up procedure as discussed with my technician and agreed upon during consultation. I fully understand and accept that non-toxic pigments are used during the procedure and that the result achieved will fade over a period of 1-3 years (sometimes more). Even once the color fades, pigment itself may stay in the skin indefinitely.
- I have been informed that the highest standards of hygiene are met and that sterile, new disposable needles and pigment containers are used for each individual client, procedure and visit.
- I understand and accept that each procedure is a process requiring multiple applications of pigment to build desired results and that 100% success cannot be guaranteed during the first procedure.
- The result of the procedure can be affected by the following: medication, skin characteristics (dry, oily, sun-damaged thick or thin skin type), personal pH balance of your skin, alcohol intake and smoking, post procedure after care.
- Upon completion, there might be swelling/redness of the skin, which will subside within 1-4 days. In some cases, bruising may occur.
- I have been advised that the true color will be seen 6 to 8 weeks after the procedure, and that the pigment may vary according to skin tones, skin type, age and skin condition. I understand that there is no guarantee on exact color outcome.
- To my knowledge, I do not have any physical, mental or medical illness, impairment or disability that might affect my well being as a direct or indirect result of my decision to have the procedure done at this time.
- I confirm that I do not have any of the contraindications and that I have gotten an OK by my doctor for any other medical conditions requiring due diligence as listed in the eligibility requirements listed above.
- I have followed all pre-procedure advice and agree to follow post-procedure instructions as provided and explained to me by the technician. Failure to do so may jeopardize my chances for a successful procedure results.

___ I confirm that I have read and understand the informed consent and pre-procedure preparation advice and have received a copy of after care instructions.

___ I confirm that I am not under the influence of drugs or alcohol, am not pregnant and desire to receive the indicated permanent makeup procedure.

Are you 18 years of age or older at the time of your scheduled permanent make up procedure? ID is required for all clients, so please make sure to bring it with you.

YES, I confirm I am 18 years of age or older at the time of my permanent make up treatment

NO, I am under 18 years old. I confirm that I will contact GLOW NORTH and requisition the option of having a parent or legal guardian sign a waiver. Minors must be 16 years of age or older. Permanent make up with parental/legal guardian are given at the sole discretion of GLOW NORTH, typically in regards to unique/special circumstances (ie. alopecia, cancer)

I understand the permanent makeup procedure carries with it known and unknown complications and consequences associated with this type of cosmetic procedure, including but not limited to: infection, scarring, inconsistent color, and spreading, fanning or fading of pigments. I understand the actual color of the pigment may be modified slightly, due to the tone and color of my skin. I fully understand this is a tattoo process and therefore not an exact science but an art. I request the permanent makeup procedure(s) and accept the permanence of this procedure, and further touch-ups, as well as, the possible complications and consequences of the said procedure.

There is a possibility of an allergic reaction to numbing agent and/or pigments (although rare). A patch test can be preformed, however it does not ensure a client will not have an allergic reaction. If a patch test is requested, it must be completed at least 48 hours before. I understand, if I have any skin treatments, laser hair removal, plastic surgery or other skin altering procedures, it may result in adverse changes to my micro pigmentation procedure. I acknowledge some of these potential adverse changes may not be correctable. I release GLOW NORTH, and Laura Brunton, from liability if I develop an allergic reaction to the pigment, or have adverse results from this procedure or any touch up/maintenance procedures.

I certify that I have read and agree to the above paragraphs and have had explained to my understanding the consent and procedure permit. I have been informed of the nature, risks, and possible complications and consequences of permanent skin pigmentation. I accept full responsibility for the decision to have this permanent makeup work done.

I give GLOW NORTH permission to perform my semi-permanent make-up procedure.
